## Former Plastic Surgeon Appeals Homicide Conviction

NASHVILLE, Tenn. - A former Nashville plastic surgeon convicted in the death of his model girlfriend was back in court Tuesday morning.

Christ Koulis and his attorneys went before the Tennessee court of criminal appeals.

A jury convicted Koulis of criminally negligent homicide two years ago. His girlfriend Lesa Buchanan died of a drug overdose during

what prosecutors called a marathon of sex and drugs during a 4th of July weekend.

Koulis is appealing his conviction.

"We are in court arguing he's not guilty. He was convicted on thin air and we want the court to grant a new trial," said Koulis' Attorney David Raybin

The State Court of Appeals will make a ruling on that request sometime in the next six months.
